*All AP Exams given at Cottonwood High School will be paper-pencil exams, except for: Chinese, Art & Design, English Language, Music Theory, and Spanish. These exams are either fully digital (Chinese, Art, and English) or have a digital component to them (Music and Spanish).

Exam Rooms:

- All exams, with the exception of Chinese, English Language, and Music Theory, will be given at the Seminary building (at the far North end of the North parking lot) in **Room 101** (listed as "Rm 101" above) or the Large Assembly Room at the back of the building. If an exam is in the Large Room, no room is listed above.
- Enter the seminary building through the East doors, near the parking lot in the front of the building.

Morning Exams:

- The exam will begin at 8:00 am, please arrive to your assigned room by **7:30 am** to check in.
- If you will need lunch from the cafeteria you MUST let your test proctor know the day of the test when you check in so we can inform the cafeteria to save you a lunch. Otherwise, **bring** your own **lunch**.

Afternoon Exams:

- The exam will begin at 12:00-Noon, please arrive to your assigned room by **11:30 am** to check in.
- It is likely that **your exam will run past school dismissal**, <u>please arrange for transportation home</u> after the exam.
- The students taking the 2:00 pm exam will already be testing. So we will take a short break between exams and continue.

Other Reminders:

- Get a good night's sleep the night before.
- **EAT**!!! Eat breakfast (and lunch) the day of your exam. We will provide a small snack during the break, but you may bring something small for the break if you want (you CANNOT eat during the exam).
- Dress in layers, you never know if the room will be warm or cool.
- Know your whole address; you may need it for the registration portion of your answer sheet.
- You will be excused from your classes at Cottonwood during the time that you are taking your exam.
- If you have a GTI class, YOU must see Ms. Oldroyd, in the Career Center, either after the exam (morning exams), or the next day (afternoon exams) to have her excuse your absence from the GTI.
- If you have an emergency and cannot make it to your AP exam, **contact Ms. Stoddard** at <u>rdstoddard@graniteschools.org</u> as soon as possible, but no later than morning of your exam.
- Be positive and come relaxed, it really does help!

What to Bring to the Exam:

- <u>Photo ID</u> (driver's license, school ID, or passport will work).
- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers, for all responses on your multiple-choice answer sheet.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for freeresponse questions in most exams.
- A watch that does not have internet access, does not beep, and does not have an alarm.
- Up to two approved calculators with the necessary capabilities if you are taking the AP Biology, Calculus AB/BC, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exams. Visit <u>https://apstudents.collegeboard.org/exam-policies-guidelines/calculator-policies</u> to find the calculator policy for your subject and the list of approved graphing calculators.
- A ruler or straightedge only if you're taking an **AP Physics** Exam. Protractors are NOT allowed.
- For digital AP Exams: A testing device that meets AP Program criteria.

What <u>NOT</u> to Bring to the Exam:

- Electronic devices (phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology of any kind, laptops, tablet computer, etc.), portable listening or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod[®], etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, and any other electronic or communication devices. School-owned recording devices and equipment are allowed only for the AP Chinese and Spanish Language and Culture Exams, English Language and Music Theory Exams.
- Books, compasses, protractors, **mechanical pencils**, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, or colored pencils.
- Scratch paper; notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets, or will be provided for some exams.
- Watches that beep or have an alarm or smartwatches.
- Computers or calculators (except as previously noted).
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Clothing or shoes with subject-related information.
- Ear plugs.
- Food or drink we will provide a small snack and water at the break.
- Clipboards.
